AS WE WERE WALKING BACK TO OUR CARS, ANOTHER CALL WAS RECEIVED IN REFERENCE TO OBJECTS BEING THROWN AT THE COMPLAINANTS HOME (255 POINCIANA DR). WE WALKED BACK TO 257 POINCIANA DR AND OBSERVED EGGS THAT WERE THROWN ALL OVER THE COMPLAINANTS (MS. ANDERSON) BACK PORCH AREA. THE EGGS WEREN'T THERE JUST MINUTES BEFORE WHEN WE WERE IN THE BACK AREA HEARING THE LOUD MUSIC. AS SOON AS WE WALKED TO THE REAR TO FIND THE EGGS, MS. CAPRA WAS ON THE SECOND FLOOR HANGING OUT HER WINDOW OF HER RESIDENCE ON THE PHONE TALKING VERY LOUDLY. SHE WAS LETTING IT BE KNOWN SHE WAS LEAVING A MESSAGE WITH THE CHIEF COMPLAINING ON ALL OFFICERS ON SCENE THAT WE WERE HARASSING HER.

I AGAIN ASKED FOR MR. CAPRA TO COME OUTSIDE SO WE COULD TALK WITH HIM SINCE HE WAS CALM AND NOT VERBALLY ABUSIVE TOWARD OFFICERS. I SHIOWED HIM THE EGGS AND EXPLAINED TO HIM ALL THIS WAS GOING TO BE DOCUMENTED ON A REPORT AND FORWARDED TO CODE ENFORCEMENT AND THE CAPTAIN OF ROAD PATROL (CAPT. SNYDER).

BEFORE WE LEFT THE SCENE, MS. ANDERSON WANTED TO BE MET. WE MET HER AT HER FRONT DOOR AND EXPLAINED WHAT WE HEARD AND GAVE HER A CASE CARD.

FIVE PHOTOS WERE TAKEN OF THE EGGS THAT WERE THROWN BY OFFICER BARRIOS.

NO FURTHER ACTION WAS TAKEN BY OFFICER.
