## **Update on the Kidnapping/Sexual Battery**

Narrative:

North Miami Beach Police Detectives have retrieved surveillance video of the above incident, from the alley way of 1026 North Miami Beach Blvd. The DVD's are now available at any time at the lobby of the North Miami Beach Police Department, 16901 NE 19 Ave, North Miami Beach, FL. In the video the 2 armed subjects we are looking for are seen walking from the left tree line to the right side of the screen. The last vehicle seen leaving the parking area in the video is believed to be the subject's vehicle. The victim was driven away in the white vehicle. Also attached to this press release is a forensic artist composite, of one of the subjects.

The suspect vehicle is described as a possible:

Toyota Sienna van, 2004/ 2005 model, dark in color, and missing the right front hub cap.

At this time, the police department is not giving any interviews or sound bites. Our detectives have no reason to believe this is connected to any other similar cases.

The North Miami Beach Police Department is asking the public to come forward if they have any information regarding this violent attack, kidnapping, and sexual battery.
