An Argument Over Missing Money Leads to Attempted Murder Charges

On February 11th 2014 at approximately 8:00 PM, North Miami Beach Police officers responded to a report of a fight at 17000 Ne 4th Avenue. The investigation revealed that 21 year old Mathieu Alexandre Jr. and group of his friends were at the above location when a female friend confronted him and accused him of stealing a small amount of cash from her vehicle, a day earlier. During this confrontation, two male friends became involved in the argument which then escalated into a physical altercation. It was at this point that Alexandre produced a handgun and pointed it at 20 year old Moller Thenor. The second male friend involved in the altercation, 26 year old Carly Sejour, tried to intervene and grab the handgun from Alexandre but was unsuccessful. Alexandre then pointed his handgun at Thenor and fired a shot, but missed. Alexandre then verbally threatened all his friends at the gathering and at the same time began to fire more shots recklessly into the air. Alexandre then fled the scene on foot and during that time he was pointing his handgun back at Sejour and Thenor.

Investigating detectives were able to track down Alexandre at his home on February 12. During their questioning of Alexandre he admitted to stealing \$80.00 from his friend's vehicle and pointing the handgun at both victims. However, he denied firing any shots at them or in the air. Detectives were granted permission to search Alexandre's room inside his home and found the handgun involved in the previous incident.

Alexandre was ultimately charged with the following:

- Attempted Murder with a Firearm
- Aggravated Assault
- Improper Exhibition of a Firearm
- Petit Theft
