I was dispatched to NW 127 ST/ NW 8 AVE regarding a person shot. Upon arrival I observed Victim 1 lying supine and motionless. Victim 2 sitting approximately 3 to 4 feet from victim 1. Victim 3 was located at 740 NW 128 ST afraid but with no injuries.

While on scene, I spoke to Mr. whom was trying to calm down Mr. Mr. stated that and were returning from the store when they found their friends with gun shot wounds.

Victim 1 was shot He was pronounced deceased by Miami-Dade Fire Rescue at 0114 hours. Victim 2 was transported to Jackson Memorial Hospital via Miami Dade Fire Rescue 26, Alarm # 5078031, Captain Herrera.

A was observed at the northeast corner of NW 8th Avenue and NW 127th Street. The which led me to Victim 4. Victim 4 was in the parking lot of Chase Bank on NW 7 AVE/ NW 127ST. Victim 4 was pronounced deceased at 0140 hours by Rescue 26, Captain Herrera, Alarm # 5078042.
