The following claim numbers do not reference a name, and at the risk of sounding like the attorney for O J Simpson, NO NAME, NO CLAIM!

I have attached a copy of the response from Joe Mayer, Community Services Director for Flagler County, when I requested from him the names associated with the above claim numbers.

Let's review the claim process as explained to me by the above mentioned Joe Mayer. When the person filed against receives a letter, the letter is addressed to the PERSON FILED AGAINST, the NAME is on the letter. That person takes the letter, walks across the hall, and gives it to Joe Mayer. That letter is what Joe Mayer e-mails to you (as you have instructed), and that letter serves as a claim form which has a person's name on it.

Claim number 275827 was not mailed to Flagler County Board of County Commissioners. It was mailed to a person at his/her HOME ADDRESS, as were all the other claim numbers referenced above.

The insurance premium for Flagler County has increased by almost \$200,000 over the last two years. The legal fees involved for very questionable claim procedures are closing in on \$40,000, and neither you nor Joe Mayer know the names connected to 13 of the 21 claim numbers listed on the spreadsheet you sent me.

The copies of the letters you receive from Joe Mayer you then send to Mark Herron and he goes on the \$\$ clock. AT LEAST 7 of the claims were for campaign violations, which are not covered by the policy.

I need the names connected to the 13 claim numbers listed above. If you cannot provide that information, as required by law, plese let me know in writing.
