RE: North Miami Police Involved Shooting Update

In an effort to show our commitment to transparency and accountability, here is the latest update from the police involved shooting in North Miami.

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) has completed their fact finding and comprehensive investigation into the North Miami Police involved shooting that occurred on Monday, July 18, 2016. On Friday, December 16, 2016, the detailed FDLE report was hand-delivered to both the City and the Miami Dade State Attorney's Office. While we understand there is a strong interest in making these facts public, the investigation has not yet reached its conclusion.

The Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office (SAO) will review the FDLE report to determine if any criminal violations were committed. At the same time, the North Miami Police Department will initiate its own internal affairs investigation to determine if any administrative regulations, policies, and procedures were violated. The SAO will determine when to release its findings following the conclusion of their investigation.

The North Miami Police Department's internal affairs investigation findings will also be made public once it is complete. The City can only release its findings after the SAO completes its investigation. The City's process could take up to 180 days. This continues to be an on-going investigation with the NMPD and the SAO.
