You and I have been lawyers for a long time and we are both able to communicate our positions very effectively without denigrating fellow advocates.

If there ever comes a time when it would be necessary to speak to you about a matter that is being reviewed by the Commission on Ethics, we will certainly reach out to you directly when the appropriate time comes in our review.
