At the hearing, the court will consider whether an injunction should be entered in this case and if so, whether other things should be ordered, including whether temporary support should be paid, custody and visitation matters if there are minor children, and whether Respondent should attend any counseling programs.

This is the final hearing. All witnesses and evidence must be presented at this time. If the Petitioner does not appear, the case may be dismissed. If the Respondent does not appear, an injunction may be entered and additional relief may be granted. Children are not permitted to testify unless a motion is filed pursuant to Fla. Fam. L.R.P. 12.407, and an order allowing the testimony is granted prior to the hearing.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND STALKING HEARINGS:

Court proceedings concerning domestic violence or stalking are required by law to be recorded. This recording may be by electronic means. No written transcript of the Court's recording will be provided to the parties. Either party may arrange for a court reporter to prepare a written transcript of the hearing at that party's expense.

REPEAT VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE, OR SEXUAL VIOLENCE HEARINGS:

The law does not require court proceedings concerning repeat, dating, or sexual violence to be recorded; however, either party may arrange for a court reporter to record the hearing and prepare a written transcript of the hearing at that party's expense. Arrangements for a court reporter must be made in advance.



The Petitioner, (a sitting City Commissioner for the City of North Miami Beach), states that the Respondent is generally unknown to the Petitioner; but the Respondent has been harassing the Petitioner.

The Petitioner states that on March 4, 2022, the Respondent posted images of the Petitioner in a bathing suit while at a hotel on her blog. The Petitioner states that the images were taken in September 2021.

The Petitioner states that in 2018, the Respondent made false allegations against the Petitioner, which the Respondent was made to retract.

The Petitioner states that the Respondent constantly harassed the Petitioner during her campaign for office in 2015.

The Petitioner states that the Respondent regularly comments on social media platforms that the Petitioner is a criminal; often using derogatory terms.


The Petitioner states that the Respondent has made approximately 40 false complaints to the Dade County and Florida Ethics Commissions; all of which have been found to be non-credible.

The Petitioner states that the Respondent makes numerous public records request regarding the Petitioner, and questions actions and proposals made by the Petitioner in her official capacity.

The Petitioner states that she has observed vehicles, unknown to her, (some with no tags), stationed outside of her residence on numerous occasions. The Petitioner states that she is also regularly followed by unknown vehicles.

The Petitioner states that the Respondent has engaged in a pattern of harassment and stalking over the past 7 seven years. The Petitioner states that she fears that the Respondent's stalking behavior will escalate endangering her life and the life of those around her including her children. The Petitioner states that the Respondent's actions have led to the Petitioner being assigned a protective detail by North Miami Beach Police. The Petitioner states that the Respondent's actions have caused emotional and physical health concerns for the Petitioner; leading the Petitioner to seek medical attention.

The Petitioner states that she fears the Respondent and is seeking the court's intervention and protection to keep the Respondent away from her. (COC-DLC)

- 1) Your hearing will be before the Judge listed on your notice of hearing and will be held **REMOTELY using the video conferencing application ZOOM. You are required to attend remotely using the ZOOM video conferencing application.**
- 2) On the date and time included in your notice, you are required to enter the ZOOM Meeting ID provided on the back of these instructions at www.zoom.us (Click Join a Meeting and enter Meeting ID). You may also join through the ZOOM application after downloading it on your device and entering the Meeting ID.
