At the adjournment of the Meeting, Commissioner Frantz Pierre shall leave the dais, and until such time as the Parties, or a court of competent jurisdiction enters an order or otherwise resolves the controversy presently pending between the City and

Commissioner Frantz Pierre in Circuit Case No. 2018-005155-CA-01(08) (Miami-Dade County) or U.S.D.C. Case No. 18-Civ-21239-Cooke (S.D. Fla.), shall not execute the powers of a Commissioner in any other matter.

- 2. The relief in this order shall be without prejudice to the respective positions of the City and Commissioner Frantz Pierre as concerns Commissioner Frantz Pierre's status as a Commissioner for the City of North Miami Beach.
- 3. The Court retains jurisdiction for enforcement of this Order.
